- Dream List ~ traveller's think about going to a destination in the future. You
 must choose a dream destination that is in another country (international
 travel). You will be booking an all-inclusive trip for one week (7 days). You
 may use one of the international destinations from Unit 5's Passport
 Adventure.
- 2. **Gather Information** ~ The potential traveller starts to collect information from friends, Internet, articles, and brochures. You must include one Trip Adviser Review, images, and other relevant information.
- 3. **Plan Itinerary** ~ Create your specific trip itinerary. This must include travel arrangements and a daily plan for 5 days of touring your destination.
 - 4. **Individualize** ~ Customizations of the trip are determined (tours, excursions). What do you plan to do? Include excursions and general spending in your budget.
- Finalize Travel Arrangements ~ The big-ticket items for the trip of finalized and purchased. (transportation, accommodations, planned excursions). This requires the creation of a trip budget.
- 6. Awareness ~ After the trip is completed, the travelers have received a deeper awareness. They now become a resource for other travelers either through on-line reviews, word of mouth, or survey responses. You must create your own Specific Trip Review. Your review must discuss the factor of safety and security while at your destination. Please Include any extra activities you enjoyed that you may not have had planned.
