

## **Customizing the Moodle Dashboard**

One of the distinct advantages of the recent Moodle update is the ability users have to customize how their dashboard works for them.


For most users, the "Course overview" default is to show "All" in "Card" view. For users with many courses, this can be a confusing, as well as a lengthy, list.



Clicking on the down arrow allows users to view only "In Progress", "Future", or "Past" courses.




The Cards can be changed to "Summary" or "List", but that doesn't solve the problem of a being presented with a lengthy list of courses, particularly if viewing "In Progress" courses that have ended or from which the user has withdrawn.




The dashboard can be customized even further, however, by "starring" courses. This is done by clicking on the three black circles beside the name of a course, in any of the "course overview" formats, and then clicking on "Star this course".

Course overview




The user is then able to view only the "Starred" courses in "Course overview".



Even when courses are "Starred", a user is still able to see all their courses in "All" view.

## Course overview



The ability of the user to customize their dashboard allows them to see exactly which courses they wish to view – All, In Progress, Future, Past, or Starred – and in what format – Card, List, or Summary.

It alleviates the "Moodle Scroll" if that is the goal of the user and allows them to sort and view their courses on their dashboard in the manner that best suits their use of Moodle.
