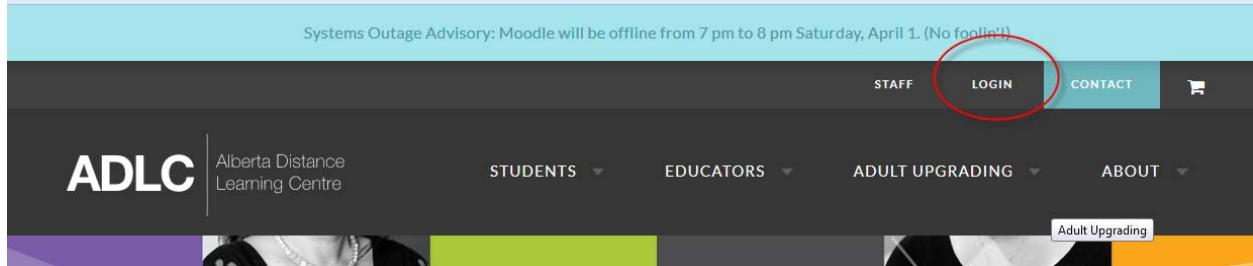


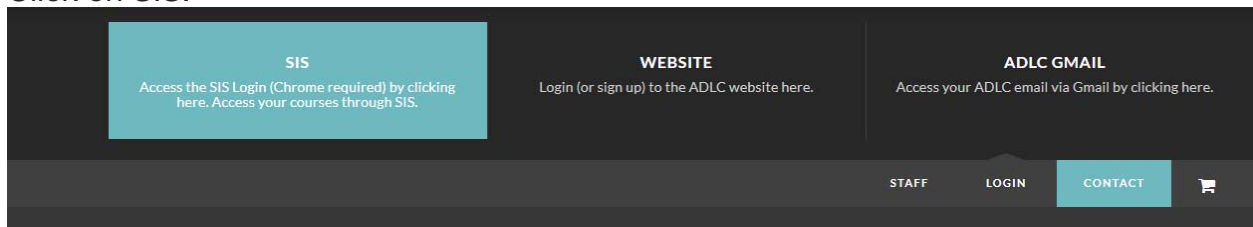
How to Post in Forums

At some point, you may have to post to a forum in your course. First you will need to log into your online course.

Go to www.adlc.ca and click on "login" found at in the top right-hand corner.



Click on SIS.



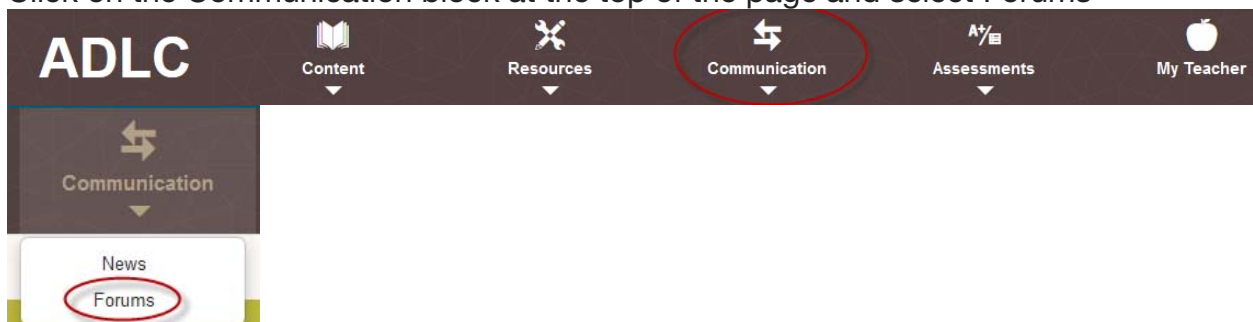
Login using your username and password then click on your course name.

a. Evaluate the sources for the two articles you have read.


b. Evaluate the risks and benefits of vaccination. (2 marks)


Fill in the title and content of your post, then click on “Post to forum” (leave the rest of the options as they are.)
