Combined Chinese New Year with Robbie Burns Day (called it Gung Haggis Fat Choy). Raises money for Asian Canadian Writers' Workshop.  Viola Irene Desmond: Helped get laws passed against separating people based on their skin colour.  Erica Samms Hurley: Promoted health care among Aboriginal women and youth, works with Aboriginal youth to teach them to respect their culture.	Todd Wong: Went to Simon Fraser University. Known as Toddish McWong during the festival. Plays Scottish songs on his accordion during the festival. Reads poetry by Asian Canadians and Robbie Burns during festival.  Viola Irene Desmond: Owned a beauty salon, was arrested for sitting in the wrong part of the theatre.  Erica Samms-Hurley: Received Governor General's Youth Award, is a registered nurse, is a Mi'kmaw from Newfoundland and Labrador.
