Year: 2012 In 2012, Jean Pollard retired after 28 years as an instructor at Red River College where she taught in the Business/Technology Teacher Education program. In 2014, Jean Pollard was presented with a Premier's Volunteer Service Year: 2014 Award by the government of Manitoba in recognition of her years of volunteer service to her community.
