First comic in 1975; Richard Comely and Ron Leishman created Captain Canuck; Wanted to create a Canadian superhero instead of always reading about American ones; Costume has a maple leaf; First comic was set in 1993.	First Captain Canuck story; Canada is most powerful nation; Tom Evens is leading Boy Scouts; Boys go missing; Aliens abducted the boys; Aliens zap Evens with zeta rays; he becomes very powerful and fast; Government make Evans a symbol of Canada who will rescue Canada whenever it is threatened.	First version lasted six years and fourteen episodes; Captain Canuck has appeared in 1993, 2004, and 2006; Name, sidekicks, and career have changed with the issues of the day.
