

## Mapping Multiple Meanings

**Definition as a noun**

warning, news or sign of something, especially in written or printed form



**Sentence**

Examples: There is a notice on wine bottles about the dangers of alcohol. The new building escaped my notice.

**Synonym**

announcement, sign; attention, observation

**Definition as a verb**

to be aware of; observe



**Sentence**

Example: I noticed that you weren't in school today.

**Synonym**

observe, perceive, remark

notice



**Definition as a noun**

a holder for keeping papers or other objects safe and in order; a line of things or people standing in order; a long thin steel tool with ridges on its surface



**Sentence**

Examples: Schools keep files on all their students. We walked down the hall in single file. Lisa filed her fingernails.

**Synonym**

catalogue, row

**Definition as a verb**

to store in a file; to present, hand in, or send; to march in line; to shape, smooth or grind down with a file or other tool



**Sentence**

Examples: The secretary filed the reports in alphabetical order. Have you filed your tax return yet? The parade filed through the town.

**Synonym**

lodge, march, grind, scrape, smooth
