## Unit 5 Vocabulary Word Wall

**In this unit**, you will learn words that are related to the **Reading and Writing of Stories** and you will also learn new words as you **read the novel** that you have chosen. Throughout the unit, you will add images/pictures for the vocabulary words and either write a sentence containing the word or be asked to write a definition of the word. In some lessons, the words will be given to you to help you understand the selections better and in other lessons, you will choose words yourself that are of interest to you.

**In this activity**, you will add an image and a definition for each word that has been placed on the wall already. The first entry — realistic fiction — has been completed for you.

**You may use your online dictionary to look up the words: Online Dictionary.** (<http://kids.wordsmyth.net/we/>)

### Instructions

- **On the Vocabulary Word Wall**, you will see that there are six words listed on the chart. Notice that, on the following pages, there is a box for each vocabulary word. The numbers in front of the words in the **Vocabulary Word Wall Chart** correspond to the word box in the following part of the **Vocabulary Word Wall**.
- **Your task is** to add the following to each word box: an image that accurately represents the word and a sentence or definition that uses the word correctly. The first entry — realistic fiction — has been completed for you.
- **To add an image**, find one online and print it out. Then cut and paste it onto the assignment.
- **In the sentence or definition box**, write a sentence using the vocabulary word or a definition of the word.
- **Add new words** in the blank spaces on the **Vocabulary Word Wall Chart**.
- **For each new word**, add an image/picture that accurately represents the word.
- **For each new word**, add a sentence or definition that uses the word correctly.

## Using an Internet Browser to Find Images

The following instructions are for the browser **Bing.com**:

- Type in your word, click on images.
- When you find an image you like: click on the image.
- Click on **Save picture as**, name your file (e.g., Conflict picture), and save to your **Pictures** file.
