Sea Otter Inlet Descriptive Language

Writers make writing interesting for the reader by using descriptive language that lets the reader clearly picture the scenes, and remember the ideas. Sometimes writers do this by using **adjectives** that vividly describe something, or a **language image** that captures the reader's interest.

- "deep seaweedy forests of kelp"
- "giant seaweeds with flat leaf-like blades"
