Questions for Creating Visions

Write your responses to the questions below.

Before Reading

Read and respond to the following questions from the article.

1	How can your hands help you "see"?	Your body compensates in other ways when you lose one of your senses. You can feel the shape of items you are creating in your hands.
2	Based on the question and the picture, what do you think the article is about?	The article is about people using clay to mold new objects or creations.
3	What background knowledge do you have of this subject?	Students may have varied knowledge from pottery courses they have taken. Others may have little or no knowledge of pottery.
