Before Reading

Answer the following:

1.	Why do people like to build models?	Answers will vary.

During Reading

If you look closely at the model you will see great details in how it was made. Answer the following questions:

1.	What is one detail that you notice about how and where the photograph was taken?	The photograph was taken from the top looking down.
2.	Where do you think the photographer stood to take the picture?	The photographer probably stood above the model (aerial shot) off to the left side and took a close up shot from above.
3.	How can you tell?	The left side is close to the viewer. Much of the site can be seen, as well as people walking to the right side of picture.

After Reading

Respond to the following:

1.	Why might a person enjoy making this village?	People might build models for enjoyment. They may have a passion about creating something from small pieces. Some people love LEGO, etc.

2.	Would you enjoy working on a complicated construction like this?	Some students may enjoy working on complicated structures such as Lego models, works of art, machines, etc. because they like working with their hands and feel proud in accomplishing a difficult task. Other students may find complicated structures overwhelming and prefer simpler tasks.
3.	Have you made LEGO models?	Answers will vary.
4.	If so, have you tried to make complicated models? Provide details about your experience.	Students should provide specific details about their successes and challenges in such difficult tasks.
