Analyzing Layout

With a partner, if possible, analyze the layout of page 42 in your textbook by answering the following questions.

1.	What catches your eye first? Why?	The village is very large and looks real because of accurate architectural details.
2.	Where is the main title or topic?	The main title is on top of page in big letters spread across a blue strip. The word Legoland is in big letters and in a different font.
3.	How is the information organized? How do you know which part to read first? Next?	The title on top is the most important information. Then the question at the top left side of page is noticeable because it is in a different colour. Information at the bottom of the page is noticed last.
4.	How do the words and images go together?	The word Legoland is in big letters to let you know that the big houses are not real but made of Lego pieces.
5.	How wide are the margins? Where else is there white space?	There are no margins except at the bottom of one page where there are questions for the students.
6.	Are the words and images in straight lines or on an angle?	The title in large letters is spread across the top in a straight line.
7.	Are drawings or borders used to add interest or make the page attractive?	One question stands out because it is in a different colour and in a circle on the page. The picture is very big and colourful so that it attracts attention.
