VISUAL IMPACT (overall quality)	The unique organization of art elements, content, & craft create a striking & memorable work. It has the power to "wow" the viewer.	The organization of art elements, content, and craft create a cohesive work; the work has lasting impact on the viewer. The student did the assignment adequately, yet work lacks conscious planning and little evidence that an overall composition was planned.	The assignment was completed and turned in, but showed little evidence of any understanding of the elements and principles of art; no evidence of planning.	The student only did the minimum, or the artwork was never completed.
TECHNIQUE (craft/ conventions)	The medium is used inventively to underscore ideas, and student demonstrates clear understanding and application of specific medium qualities.	The medium is used effectively, to underscore ideas, and student demonstrates some understanding and application of specific medium qualities.	The medium is used adequately to underscore ideas, and student is developing an understanding of specific medium qualities.	Use of the medium shows little evidence of how to enhance ideas, and student has difficulty manipulating medium qualities.	Use of the medium unclearly underscores ideas; is poorly executed and/or incomplete.
