



## Steps for Creating a Poster

Posters communicate information through words and pictures. The style of a poster depends on the topic and message you are trying to communicate.

### Step #1

#### **Identify your topic and message.**

Consider focusing on a topic that you know a lot about, one that connects with things you are learning, one that is of personal interest, or a topic that many people have different opinions about.

### Step #2

#### **Plan the design and layout of your poster.**

Consider the theme of your poster and design it in a way that reflects that theme. For example, for an exciting look use bright colours, and for a more serious look use dark or neutral colours.

### Step #3

#### **Collect and create information and graphics.**

Choose graphics that suit (match) your topic. For example, a fun or personal interest topic could use cartoon graphics, and a serious topic could use photographs and diagrams.

### Step #4

#### **Put it all together.**

Choose a font or writing style that fits with the topic, lay things out so that your poster looks balanced, and use colour to emphasize certain things or as a theme.

### Step #5

#### **Reflect.**

Reflect on your work and the process you followed to complete your poster. How would you create a poster differently next time?
