1. In this workbook, you examined various departments of the federal government. Refer to your *Government Departments and Agencies* handout to assist you with this assignment.

Example of the influence of **one** federal government department or agency:

The Canadian Revenue Agency (CRA) has an influence on my quality of life because it is involved in collecting taxes from Canadian citizens (including me!). These funds are used to provide various social services to Canadians. The amount of taxes taken from my income by the CRA has a direct impact on my life because it determines the amount of disposable income (money after taxes and paying for necessities) I have left to spend on things I enjoy such as travelling, eating at restaurants, going to movies, and purchasing goods such as DVDs and CDs. I am also affected directly by the CRA because the funds collected from taxes have ensured I have the ability to access health care services I need such as a doctor, dentist, and hospital.

Note: You may **not** use the example provided above.

→ Remember, you must illustrate the **federal** government's influence on **your** life.
