Concept Maps

You are likely familiar with mind maps. **Mind maps** place the central idea or concept in the centre and then organize related ideas around the central idea.

Concept maps are similar to mind maps. However, **concept maps** start from the top and flow downward from the central concept. Concept maps use linking words, such as verbs, to establish relationships. Mind maps do not use linking words.
