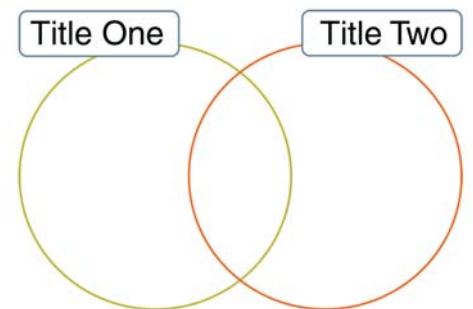

Characteristics of the English and French Fur Trade Chart

Characteristics of the French Fur Trade	Same	Characteristics of the English Fur Trade
<ul style="list-style-type: none">- based in New France- travelled to First Nations to trade- travelled by canoe from Montreal to the Rocky Mountains- used canoes extensively- worked closely with First Nations- intermarried and created the Metis people	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- used the barter system to trade fur for goods- sent furs to Europe by ship- depended on First Nations for knowledge, geography, medicine	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- based in England- required First Nations to bring furs to English forts- travelled by canoe from Albany factory to the Rocky Mountains- used canoes but not extensively- did not work closely with the First Nations
