#1 What do each of the three sources present on page 6 and 7 about the role of Government in society?

AND

#2 Considering all the sources together presented on pages 6 and 7, what do you think should be the role of the government in society?

A format that works- You can always expand and be more creative in your writing.

Introduction (Optional) -Three to five sentences on the broad topic of the three sources or from the question like above in the box. Topics will be from the course themes like (Identity and ideology, individualism and collectivism and common good, origins of Liberalism, rejection of liberalism, democratic and economic equality, viability of liberalism, ideology and citizenship and taking action. So think about these when examining sources. Which theme are they about?

Three Source Paragraphs- You should thoroughly explain the time and place and what this source is revealing and possibly the perspective or ideology. Examine the details, the words, fine print and possible explanations with the sources. Do not forget to answer question #1 here. What does the source communicate?

Conclude- Answer question #2 here or else you have not revealed the link/ relationship between the three sources. Consider them together and analyse what they communicate together. What ideology, country, or theme from the course is it linked to? Give your own thoughts or opinions to justify your statement about the relationship. It is always great to do this with some terminology from social studies courses. Do not be afraid to include current affairs to justify or prove your statements.
