- 2. A toy company wants to air television advertisements aimed at children. The province does not allow commercial advertising aimed at children under 13. Does this law unjustifiably limit freedom of expression?
- 3. The Gazette, the school-sponsored newspaper of Campbell Elementary, is written and edited by students. The school principal has found two of the articles in the issue to be inappropriate, and ordered that the pages on which the articles appeared be

withheld from publication. Has the principal unjustifiably limited freedom of expression?
