Venn Diagram

Venn Diagram

- If you are using the printable template to complete the **Venn Diagram**, then, print the page containing the template.
 - In the first title space, write the **First Product Package**.
 - In the second title space, write the **Second Product Package**.
 - The overlapping space will be where you enter information that pertains to both packages.

Example Chart for Comparing Packaging

Milk Jug	Both (pertains to both packages)	Milk Carton
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• made with plastic• screw lid keeps the milk from spilling• has a built-in handle• needs to have a sticker label on it	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• both hold milk• both made of recyclable materials• both come in 1-litre, 2-liter, and 4-litre sizes	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• made of cardboard covered in plastic• can come in small sizes• has peel-open lid from which milk can spill• has no handle• has a label printed directly on the carton
