Social Studies 30-1 4.2.9 Conflicting Ideologies Assignment

Total 110 marks

In this section, you considered the impact of ideological conflict on international affairs, by studying the impact of the Cold War from 1945-1991. Many strategies were employed by both sides as the conflicting ideologies of liberal democracy and communist totalitarianism strove for ideological domination.

This assignment is intensive, however, will become a very useful tool when preparing for written samples on the midterm, final and diploma exams. Be sure to review all the readings from this section before you complete this assignment, as well as Chapter 7 pages 234-260 in your textbook. Your Social 30-1 Moodle pages in Unit Four will have many related videos and other resources to aid you in this process.

Step One: Define the methods of Cold War Conflict

In <u>your own words</u>, answer the questions listed within each box on an individual slide. Completing this task will allow you to both understand and describe the impact and importance of the Cold War both on history and in respect to ideology.

Your answers for each question should fit on the slide(s) that have been indicated. The story components have been laid out for you, however, it is your responsibility to provide the appropriate depth and description to clearly communicate the key terms, explain important events and or concepts and to connect the events to each other. It is vital you put this information in your own words to demonstrate your understanding and to avoid plagiarism.

Each page (where the photo is "paperclipped" to the powerpoint background) should have a APA cited image of your choosing, related to the concepts outlined on the slide. Remember, you will have to complete research, so resources will also need to be listed in your assignment bibliography, in APA format.

IMPORTANT*NOTE: There is a downloadable Powerpoint/Slides file you can download, edit and resubmit with all the questions listed below already on it. Using this file is not mandatory but strongly suggested as it will save you significant amounts of time and effort. It will be on the 4.2.9 Assignment page of Moodle.
