2-1: Section 1: Atlantic Region Postcard

Inquiry

You have looked at the Atlantic region on a map, identified its physical features, climate, and industries in these first four lessons. Make a postcard using an image(s) from Atlantic Canada. You can use the Post Card Creator (**Read Write Think** website) or make the postcard using the **Post Card Template** below.

Criteria

1. On the front: Include a photograph or drawing of an Atlantic physical feature or natural resource. Provide a caption or title for the picture.
 - To insert an image on your post card, click on the grey bordered space below, browse to the location of your image file, click on the file name to select it, then, click Open.
2. On the back: On the right hand side include a message to a friend or family member in the Maritimes that shows what you know about:
 - one physical feature of the area (landforms, bodies of water, etc.) and how it affects people
 - the climate of the area and how it affects people
 - one natural resource of the area and how it affects people
3. On the right hand side of the back include in the address of your friend in the Maritimes, the capital city and province in which the landform or industry is located.
