

Completing Assignments Electronically

In this course, you may complete your assignments either by hand or electronically.

- If you complete your assignments by hand, either physically mail them in, or scan and submit them using the Dropbox. If you scan them, please try to use a single file with a small file size.
- If you choose to complete your assignments using a word processor such as Word, you may find it useful to download and install the following programs.
 - MathType - <http://www.dessci.com/en/products/mathtype/trial.asp>
 - Download and install the trial version. When the trial ends, you are left with the lite version, which has enough functionality for this course.
 - This program can piggyback on Word and is fairly intuitive. If you plan to use this program regularly, it is worth learning some shortcuts (e.g. For Windows users, ctrl+f gives the fraction template and ctrl+r gives the square root template).
 - Geogebra - <http://www.geogebra.org/cms/download>
 - Select either the Windows or Mac version and install it on your computer.
