Assignment 1-1 Respect Cartoon

Choose an event from your own life or an incident from “I Meet the Sheriff” by Ralph Moody or “Dr. Johnson and his Father” by James Baldwin. Create a comic strip that demonstrates how an individual shows respect to others such as family or community members.

When you are creating your comic strip, make sure to keep the following points in mind:

- Comic strips are usually colourful and eye-catching. The artist will choose two or three colours to use most often in the comic strip.
- Make sure you use the word respect and clearly show what words, actions, characters, or ideas are respectful.
- Your comic strip should tell your story clearly so that everyone who looks at it can understand what you are saying.
- Don't make your comic strip panels too cluttered. Otherwise, it might be hard for people to read.
- Since your comic strip is quite short, don't choose more than two or three characters.
- Have fun! Most comics are funny and entertain the reader. As long as you can tell your story in your comic, it is just fine for it to be funny.
- You may print this file, draw the cartoon and take a picture of it. Or, you may use an online cartoon maker, take a picture of it and submit the photo, or you may email the link or cartoon to your teacher. Be sure your teacher can access the link.
