
FOR 2030 – Regulating Alberta's Forests ASSIGNMENT – LAT Report

STEP 1 – Ensure that you have watched the instructional video on the Moodle assignment page.

STEP 2 - Follow the steps to create a Landscape Analysis Report using the Landscape Analysis Tool (LAT).

Step 4 - Adding Proposed Activities in LAT Using the Draw LAT Activity Tool

To enter proposed activities, complete the 3 steps, as illustrated below.



- 1. Click on LAT Tasks -> LAT Editor.
- 2. Enter a name for the new proposed activity layer. (STUDENT_NAME FOR2030).
- 3. Click OK.
- 4. Select Activity Layer: Click on the drop down arrow to select the proposed activity layer name. (You created this in Step 2.)
 - (STUDENT_NAME FOR2030)
- 5. Select the Disposition Type.
 - Choose RVC Vegetation control Easement - we are applying to log a fireguard.
- 6. Select the Geometry Type (Polygon).
- 7. Select the Purpose Type (Fire Hazard Management).
- 8. Select the Activity Type. (Fireguard)

Select Activity Layer: STUDENT_NAME_FOR2030 Draw Type: Polyline: Polygon: Disposition Types: RVC - Vegetation Control Easement Purpose Types: Fire Hazard Management Activity Types: Fireguard (FHCP01RVCR) Buffer (meters): 30 x 30

Step 5 - Drawing Proposed Activity

- 1. Immediately click on the map to start drawing, clicking for every point on your border.
- 2. Double click to end making your selection.






Step 6 - Create a LAT Report

1. Select the LAT Report Icon.



- 2. Select the Activity Layer.
- 3. Fill in the required information as shown.
- Make sure Group Activity Types is **NOT** selected
- 5. Choose the **Submit** button
- You will immediately receive a confirmation that your LAT report request has been submitted.
- In approximately 2 minutes you will receive your LAT report.
