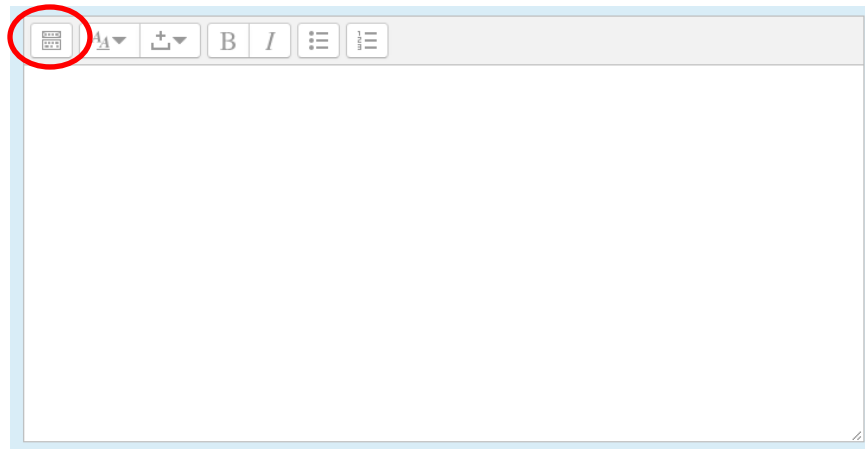
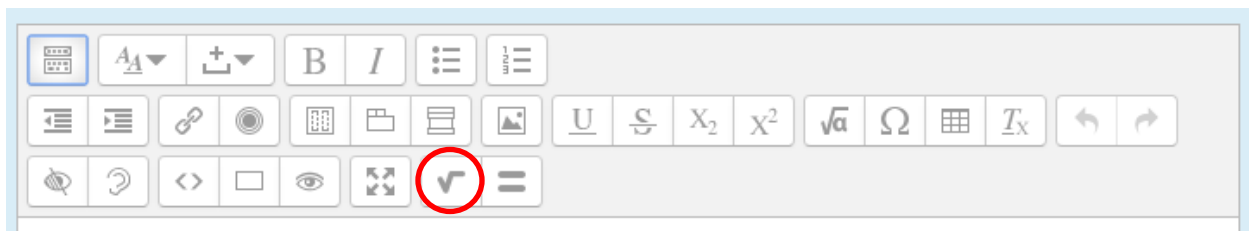


How to Type Math Symbols and Equations in Moodle Quizzes

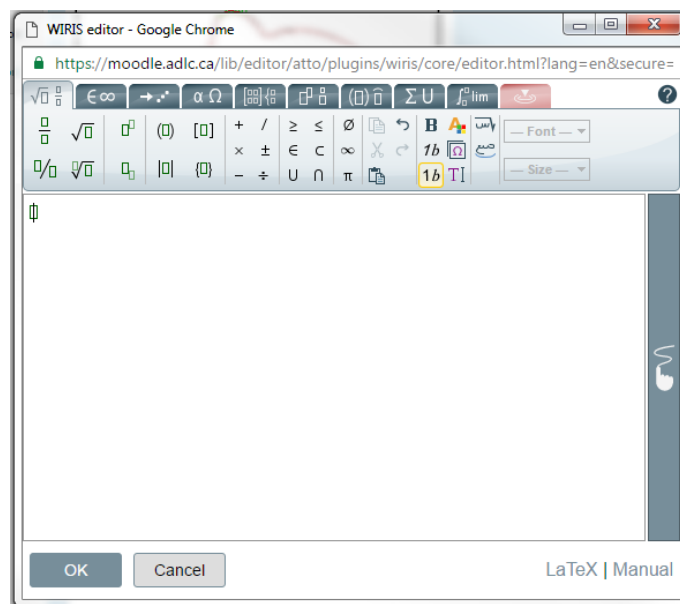
1. Click on the toolbar expansion button.



2. Now that the toolbar is expanded, click on the WIRIS editor button.



3. Wait for the WIRIS editor to load. It will look like this once it has loaded completely.



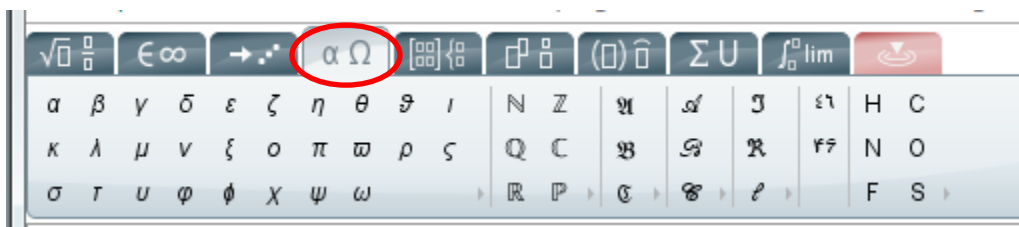
4. The first tab is called the General Tab. You will see that this is where you can find fractions, radical signs and a few common symbols. You will need to use your computer keyboard to type numbers. You can also use the keyboard for the +, - and = signs.



The second tab is called the Symbols tab. You may find this tab useful for symbols (like the degree symbol °) that are not included in the General tab.



The fourth tab is called the Greek Letter and Numbers tab. You may find this one handy for theta θ or number systems like the Real Numbers \mathbb{R} .



5. As is the case with anything new, you will need to experiment a bit to learn how to use this tool best. And of course, as you become more familiar with this tool you will get faster and faster at typing your math.

Remember you do still have the option to hand write and upload a PDF (scan) or JPG (picture) of your hand-written work.
