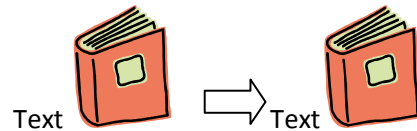
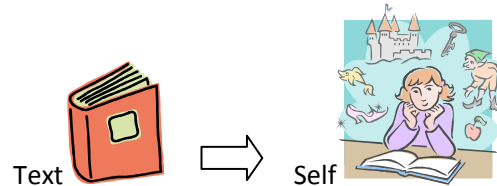


Reading Strategies

Author's Purpose

Every author has a purpose for creating a story or image. They write to either:

Persuade: to convince the reader of a certain point of view

Inform: to teach or give information to the reader

Entertain: to hold the attention of the reader
