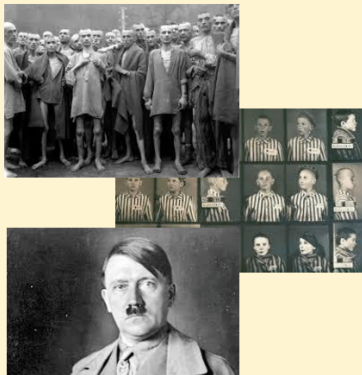
The Holocaust - Background Information

What reasons did the aggressor state hold as justification of the genocide?

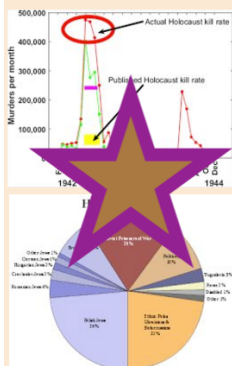
