USING THE GRID OR TIC-TAC-TOE

Do you have problems knowing where to start when you are looking at a visual image. It is very easy to miss the little details that can make all the difference in your response. A student taught me this method they had learned in another class.

First: Pay careful attention to an exerpt that may accomplany the visual image

Next: AFTER looking at the image, draw a grid over the image. Go section by section circling or noting important information that may help you identify the THEME.
